

# MILITARY FRIENDLY TIPS

## Active Duty Military Tuition Assistance (TA)

College credit may be awarded for courses completed at Military Service Schools. The official Joint Services Transcript displaying military course completions must be requested by the student to be sent directly to the Registrar by the issuing agency. Visit the CCTC office at the Shaw AFB Spratt Education Center for assistance with admissions, degree plan management and processing military TA requests.

## South Carolina National Guard College Assistance Program (SCNG CAP)

The SCNG College Assistance Program will pay 100% of college tuition and fees at state supported institutions up to \$4,500 per year, with a cap of \$18,000 per service-member. After the application is received, the service-member notifies the financial aid office of their eligibility, confirmation of eligibility is made with CHE and financial disbursement is made directly to the school by CHE. ## Military Spouse Tuition Assistance

There are a number of financial aid resources available to military-affiliated students enrolled with CCTC, including the Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA) for eligible military spouses. Active Duty military and their family members are afforded in-state tuition status immediately upon completion of an Active Duty Military Verification Form or Military Dependent Verification Form.

MyCAA eligible students, spouses of E1 - E5, O1 - O2 and W1 - W2, can qualify for up to \$4000 toward an Associate degree or Certificate program that is not a general studies or liberal arts program. ## CLEP and DANTES Testing

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES) tests may be taken and credit will be awarded provided the appropriate scores are attained. *The \$15 administrative fee is waived for Active Duty Military.*
