QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT THE CCTC EMPLOYEE CAMPAIGN

What is the Employee Giving Campaign?

The Hero Central Employee Campaign is an organized fundraising effort that encourages CCTC's faculty and staff members to support a program or initiative within the campaign's strategic priorities that is most meaningful to them. Collectively, our gifts will continue to build a philanthropic foundation and fund critical projects and programs that will make a lasting impact on current and future generations of CCTC scholars and employees.

Why does Central Carolina need faculty and staff support?

The Hero Central Employee Campaign marks an extraordinary transformation in the life of Central Carolina Technical College. When staff and faculty members participate in the Hero Central Employee Campaign, CCTC gains much more than dollars toward our fundraising goal. Contributing employees demonstrate to everyone that the mission, the project and the college MATTER, especially to those who carry it out every day. Is my gift tax-deductible?

The CCTC Foundation is operated exclusively for charitable education purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. Gifts to the CCTC Foundation are tax-deductible to the fullest extent of state and federal laws.

When was the last employee campaign?

We are proud of the fundraising that takes place here and will continue to offer opportunities to give for organizations like the United Way and the American Heart Association, but we will give preference to our own campaign.
