- ✓ Are you an in-state resident as determined by SC residency laws?
- ✓ Are you a resident of Clarendon, Kershaw, Lee or Sumter County?
- ✓ Will you graduate from a public or private accredited high school in Clarendon, Kershaw, Lee or Sumter county?
- ✓ Are you a homeschool graduate?
- ✓ Are you a graduate of the South Carolina Virtual High School or a statewide online school recognized by the SC Department of Education?
- ✓ Does your final high school transcript show a minimum GPA of 2.0?
