

2021-2022 Dependent Verification Worksheet (V1, V5)

Your 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called Verification. Federal law requires the CCTC Financial Aid Office to compare the information from your FAFSA with copies of your 2019 IRS Federal tax returns (and parents since you are considered dependent for federal aid purposes) or other financial aid documents. This process is required before awarding federal student aid.

- Bring this worksheet both completed and signed by you and at least one parent to the Financial Aid Office on your campus. *Attach any required documentation.*
- Bring a signed copy of your 2019 Federal income tax return. To request a copy of your 2019 Tax Return Transcript and/or W-2 Form(s), contact the Internal Revenue Services at IRS.GOV.
- The Financial Aid Office may ask you for additional information or documentation. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may be corrected by the Financial Aid Office.

Note: If your parents' tax filing status was "Married Filing Separately", you must submit both parents tax returns/transcripts. If your parent became married after filing their 2019 taxes and before the date the FAFSA was signed, you must also submit their spouses 2019 tax information. If you or your parent had an amended tax return, we will also require a copy of the Amended Tax Return (1040X). If parents were married on or before December 31, 2019—tax filing status must reflect Married Filing Joint or Married Filing Separately on tax return/transcript. If parents were separated on or before December 31, 2019—valid documentation must be submitted to verify separation for amendment of taxes to not be required.
