American Rescue Plan (ARP)

1. Central Carolina Technical College signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, funds received under Section 2003(a)(1) of the ARP Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is **\$5,382,834**.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 2003(a)(1) of the ARP Act and as of September 30, 2021 is **\$3,357,772**.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 2003(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act is **2,583**.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 2003(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act is **2,583**.
6. The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 2003(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act were:
 - a. Students must have been enrolled in June 2021 at Central Carolina Technical College in the summer 2021 term. Based on the funding available, the college made the decision to award \$1,000 to Pell grant students, and \$700 to the other students in the summer of 2021.
 - b. Students must have been enrolled in September 2021 at Central Carolina Technical College in the fall 2021 term. Based on the funding available, the college made the decision to award \$1,200 to Pell grant students, and \$900 to the other students in the fall of 2021.
 - c. The balance not yet awarded will be used to award any students who may have been unintentionally left out, and to award additional amounts based on documented need.
7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants: See attached letter that was provided to all students who received the grant in June 2021 and in September 2021.

Dear CCTC Titan,

Central Carolina Technical College is happy to report that we are able to continue to assist students with federal COVID-19 relief funding. This funding continues to help college students whose lives have been disrupted, many of whom still face financial challenges and struggle to make ends meet. This emergency financial aid grant is designed to help cover expenses, such as tuition, fees, books, food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and childcare.

The legislation requires that colleges make grants based on the needs of students. Unpaid balances will result in late fees, holds placed on your account, inability to receive grades/transcripts, or register for the next semester until paid.**
