

1. The Federal Government established the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Stability Act (CARES Act) on March 27, 2020, a portion of which, Student Aid Funds, us to be used to provide emergency assistance to students. Supplemental funds were later authorized through the Coronavirus Response and relief Supplemental Appropriations Act 2021 (CRRSAA/HEERF II) and the American Rescue Plan (ARP/HEERF III) to continue support for institutions of higher education to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic. Central Carolina Technical College signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Dear CCTC Titan,

Central Carolina Technical College is happy to report that we are able to continue to assist students with federal COVID-19 relief funding. This funding continues to help college students whose lives have been disrupted, many of whom still face financial challenges and struggle to make ends meet. This emergency financial aid grant is designed to help cover expenses, such as tuition, fees, books, food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and childcare.

The legislation requires that colleges make grants based on the needs of students. Therefore, the amount you receive will differ depending on whether or not you are eligible for a Pell Grant this academic year. Remember, these funds are not a loan and will not be considered in your financial aid award package for this academic year.

As a student enrolled in the Fall 2021 semester as of November 16, 2021, you qualify for this student emergency grant. Pell grant eligible students will receive \$1,200 and others will receive \$900. If you have a current balance due to the college, it is highly recommended you use these funds to pay towards your balance. If you do not, you will need to make payment arrangements with the billing office for any balance due. Unpaid balances will result in late fees, holds placed on your account, inability to receive grades/transcripts, or register for the next semester until paid.

The funds will be sent through the normal Bank Mobile refund process this Wednesday, November 17, 2021. Make sure your refund preference has been selected with BankMobile. For more information about BankMobile, visit this link: <https://bankmobiledisbursements.com/student-experience/>.
