Program Components



Tuition

- Tuition for the fall and spring semester are covered through a grant
- Out-of-Pocket Expenses:
 - Books (some school districts pay for books)
 - Transportation
 - Footwear or safety equipment



How Does Youth Apprenticeship Work?

- CCTC connects qualified students with participating employers
- Students complete an extensive application and screening process
- Employers interview and hire the students
- Students begin part-time employment while taking high school and college courses

Eligibility Requirements:

- Rising junior or senior in Sumter, Clarendon, Kershaw and Lee County
- Minimum of 16 years of age*
 Insurance and liability is covered through CCTC
- Must meet CCTC academic requirements for program of study
- Students are required to attend Career Readiness Training

*Some companies will have other qualifications for certain occupations.



Career Readiness Training

- 12 hours of training
- 6 hours required as part of application process
 - Resume writing
 - How to prepare for an interview
 - Mock interviews
 - Communication: before, during & after interview
- 6 hours prior to starting job
 - Teamwork
 - Conflict resolution
 - Problem solving
 - Personal finance



What Will the Student Earn Upon Successful Completion?

- High School Diploma
- Credits towards CCTC's Certificate or Degree
- Credential from the U.S. Department of Labor
- One year of work experience



Application Process

- Complete application packet
 - Request application by emailing <u>apprenticeships@cctech.edu</u>
- Attend Part 1 of Career Readiness Training
- Interview with employers
- Enroll at CCTC
- Attend Part 2 of Career Readiness Training
- Begin classes at CCTC
- Start working!



General Information

- All hiring decisions are made by the employer
- This is a competitive program not everyone will be selected
- Career Readiness Training is required, and does not guarantee acceptance in the program
- One year commitment
- Must have reliable transportation
- Grades and attendance matter
 - Failing grades my jeopardize continuation in the program and eligibility to receive Lottery Tuition Assistance
